ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS for the 244931 Fixture


Important Safety information (Please read before proceeding)

1. Remove the fixture, parts and all mounting hardware bags (orange) from the carton and verify that all parts are present according to the illustration sheet. All parts must be used as indicated. Do not replace any parts, leave any parts out, or use any parts which are worn out or broken. Failure to follow the instructions could cause a hazardous situation, voids the warranty and violates the U.L. listing of the fixture.

2. To prevent the electric shock, turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture. NEVER attempt to install, clean or replace bulbs without shutting off the electricity to the fixture.

3. Never use light bulbs with wattage ratings that exceed the fixtures maximum rating. Always make sure the electric current is turned off before changing the bulbs. 4. If you experience difficulties installing the lighting fixture or it fails to work as expected, please contact a local qualified licensed electrical contractor.

5. Please contact your local Capital Lighting Fixture reseller with any assembly or installation questions. Your local reseller can also provide you with replacement parts for your new fixture.

Assembly Instructions for Hanging the 244931 Fixture with a Chain:

1. Pass lead wire from top of Light Cluster (17) through Bottom Center Pipe (16), Fixture (15) ,Top Center Pipe (14) and Loop (13), then screw all together tightly.

2. Raise Glass Shade (21) over Light Cluster (17), make sure Glass Assembly Holes (20) and Assembly Holes of Decor Trim (18) are in line, then secure Glass Shade (21) and Decor Trim(18) with Thumb Screws (19).

3. Pass lead wire through one Chain Link (12), Chain (10), another Chain Link (12), Loop (11), Nipple (09) and Canopy (07), then slip Lock Washer (06), thread Hex Nut (05) onto Nipple (09). Finally, tighten Hex Nut (05) to secure Loop (11) onto Canopy (07) together.

4. Find appropriate threaded holes on Mounting Bar (01), and assemble Mounting Screws (02) into threaded holes with Hex Nuts (03).

5. Attach Mounting Bar (01) to Outlet Box with Outlet Box Mounting Screws (04).

6. Raise whole Fixture (14) toward outlet box, then connect fixture ground wire to the outlet box ground wire with wire connector supplied; connect the common wire of the lamp cord to the power supply white wire with wire connector supplied; connect supply wire of the lamp cord to the power supply black wire with wire connector supplied. *Note: This fixture is wired using 2 conductor Lamp cord. The insulation between the two conductors on the lamp cord can be split down the center for better access to the two conductors. The common wire on the lamp cord is identified as the conductor with ribs embossed in the rubber wire insulation.*

7. Push fixture to ceiling, carefully passing Mounting Screws (02) through holes in Canopy (07), then verify all wires are securely inside Canopy (07). Finally, secure fixture to ceiling with Cylinder Nuts (08).



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

Assembly Instructions to Flush Mount the 244931 fixture:

1. Remove pre-wired loop from top of Fixture (10), then Pass lead wire through Light Cluster (12), Bottom Center Pipe (11), Fixture (10), Top Center Pipe (09), Canopy (07), then slip Lock Washer (06), thread Hex Nut (05) onto nipple end of Fixture Top (10). Finially, screw all together tightly.

2. Raise Glass Shade (16) over Light Cluster (12), make sure Glass Assembly Holes (15) and Assembly Holes of Decor Trim (13) are in line, then secure Glass Shade (16) and Decor Trim(13) with Thumb Screws (14).

3. Find appropriate threaded holes on Mounting Bar (01), and assemble Mounting Screws (02) into threaded holes with Hex Nuts (03).

4. Attach Mounting Bar (01) to Outlet Box with Outlet Box Mounting Screws (04).

5. Raise whole Fixture (10) toward outlet box, then connect fixture ground wire to the outlet box ground wire with wire connector supplied; connect the common wire of the lamp cord to the power supply white wire with wire connector supplied; connect supplied; connect supply black wire with wire connector supplied. *Note: This fixture is wired using 2 conductor Lamp cord. The insulation between the two conductors on the lamp cord can be split down the center for better access to the two conductors. The common wire on the lamp cord is identified as the conductor with ribs embossed in the rubber wire insulation.*

6. Push fixture to ceiling, carefully passing Mounting Screws (02) through holes in Canopy (07), then verify all wires are securely inside Canopy (07). Finally, secure fixture to ceiling withCylinder Nuts (08).
