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# ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS for the 252812MA Fixture

### Important Safety information (Please read before proceeding)


1. Remove the fixture, parts and all mounting hardware bags (orange) from the carton and verify that all parts are present according to the illustration sheet. All parts must be used as indicated. Do not replace any parts, leave any parts out, or use any parts which are worn out or broken. Failure to follow the instructions could cause a hazardous situation, voids the warranty and violates the U.L. listing of the fixture.

2. To prevent the electric shock, turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture. **NEVER attempt to install, clean or replace bulbs without shutting off the electricity to the fixture.** 

3. Never use light bulbs with wattage ratings that exceed the fixtures maximum rating. Always make sure the electric current is turned off before changing the bulbs.

4. If you experience difficulties installing the lighting fixture or it fails to work as expected, please contact a local qualified licensed electrical contractor.

5. Please contact your local Capital Lighting Fixture reseller with any assembly or installation questions. Your local reseller can also provide you with replacement parts for your new fixture.



## Assembly Instructions to Chain Mount the 252812 MA Fixture

- 1. Pass Lead wire from top of Fixture (12) thru Loop (11), onto end of Fixture Top (12) tightly.
- 2. Find appropriate threaded holes on Mounting Bar (1) and assemble Mounting Screws (3) into threaded holes with Hex Nuts (13).
- 3. Attach Mounting Bar (1) to the Outlet Box with Outlet Box Mounting Screws (2).
- 4. Attach Loop (6) with Canopy (7) by tighting Hex Nut (4) and Washer (5) with Loop (6).
- 5. Attach Chain (10) with Loop (6) using Chain Links (9).

6. Pass lead wire and ground wire through chain links no more than 3 inches apart, then pass wires through, Canopy (7), into Outlet Box.

7. Connect fixture ground wire to the outlet box ground wire with wire connector supplied; connect the common wire of the lamp cord to the power supply white wire with wire connector supplied; connect supply wire of the lamp cord to the power supply black wire with wire connector supplied. *Note: This fixture is wired using 2 conductor Lamp cord. The insulation between the two conductors on the lamp cord can be split down the center for better access to the two conductors. The common wire on the lamp cord is identified as the conductor with ribs embossed in the rubber wire insulation.* 

8. Push fixture (12) to ceiling, carefully passing Mounting Screws (3) through holes in Canopy (7), then verify all wires are securely inside Canopy (7).

9. Finally, secure fixture (12) to the ceiling with Metal Cylindrical Nuts (8).



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
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### Assembly Instructions to Flush Mounting 252812MA fixture

1. Pass lead wire and ground wire through Canopy (7) no more than 3 inches apart, into Outlet Box.

2. Find appropriate threaded holes on Mounting Bar (1) and assemble Mounting Screws (3) into threaded holes with Hex Nuts (4).

3. A ach Mounting Bar (1) to the Outlet Box with Outlet Box Mounting Screws (2).

4. Pass lead wire and ground wire through Canopy (7), then slip Lock Washer (6), Thread Hex Nut (5) onto fixture top. Finally, tighten Hex Nut (5) to secure Canopy (7).

5. Connect fixture ground wire to the outlet box ground wire with wire connector supplied; connect the common wire of the lamp cord to the power supply white wire with wire connector supplied; connect supply wire of the lamp cord to the power supply black wire with wire connector supplied. *Note: This fixture is wired using 2 conductor Lamp cord. The insulation between the two conductors on the lamp cord can be split down the center for be er access to the two conductors. The common wire on the lamp cord is idenfied as the conductor with the printed marking and or the ribs embossed in the rubber wire insulation.* 

6. Push fixture (9) to ceiling, carefully passing Mounting Screws (3) through holes in Canopy (7), then verify all wires are securley inside Canopy (7).

7. Finally, secure fixture (9) to the ceiling with Metal Cylindrical Nuts (8).
